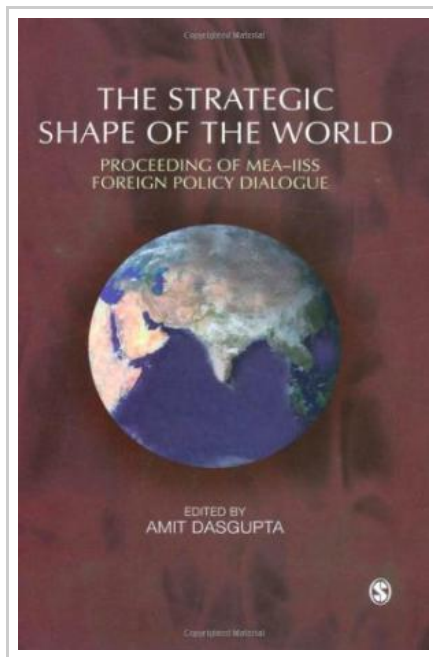




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The Strategic Shape of the World: Proceedings of MEA-IISS Foreign Policy Dialogue
