

Hutchison, Cooperative Observer at Monmouth, 111., died May 11, 1916. Prof. Hutchison was for many years an instructor in Monmouth College and served as weather observer from 1884 to 1894. He then moved to lowa but returned later and served again as Government observer from 1911 until his death. He was 84 years of age, the oldest observer in the State. He prepared the meteorological reports for the Monmouth dailr papers and in this work he was unusually interested and attentive. Prof. Hutchison was much loved and respected in his community and the Weather Bureau has lost an efficient and conscientious worker. The departures from normal temperature and precipitation are computed only for such stations as have ten or more years of record, but all complete reports are used in determining section or division means.
